Agreement:

When you enroll your child in TAP at Ute Pass Elementary, you are giving your child permission to participate and will encourage him/her to attend regularly.

Bus transportation is available for all afterschool programs. If you are picking up your child, Parents must arrange to have their children picked up ON TIME per the class times listed in the brochure. A childcare fee may be assessed for children not picked up within 5 minutes after the end of class. Chronic late pick-up will result in your child's dismissal from TAP classes.

You and your child understand that disruptive behavior will not be tolerated and may result in temporary removal from the TAP class or dismissal from the program. Fees are not refundable should your child drop out or be dismissed for any reason.

Full and partial scholarships are available on a limited and confidential basis. Proof of need is not required; simply fill out the space on the enrollment form to request a scholarship.
