Technology w/ Ms. Olimb- Review of Board Presentation District Technology. Infrastructure has been updated in all buildings over the last 1-2 years. Services have been moved to Cloud for added security. There are a vast array of digital media options and digital supports for literacy in MS and HS. Social Media presence is increasing for all schools, new district facebook page has 200 followers in 1 month. Improvements to school and district websites for ease of access and ability to find information.

Integrate Calendars with Manitou Springs City organizations? Ms. Olimb added that this should be doable through Partners for Healthy Choices.

Technology is building a Cyber Security/Cyber Safety program for faculty, students, and parents.

Parent Question- can digital communications and social media presence include students and possibly a course offering? High School Journalism in 2020-21 will have a separate digital newspaper/media course and a separate yearbook class. Currently these are housed in one Advanced Journalism class.
